8th Episode of

Tectonic Elements of NW Himalaya

7 Days (22-28 July, 2023) camping/hoteling if available.

Details and Objective:

As a result of collision, thrusting & uplift, the Himalayan and Karakoram ranges were developed. Glaciers, streams and rivers have formed cross-sectional windows through these mountain ranges. Various exposed rocks, tectonics and structure of the collisional zone have been inviting researchers to explore geology through these windows. During this trip to Yasin Valley, KKH/ CPEC and Gilgit-Yasin roads will lead us to the MKT. In this trip, we mainly used the published literature of Dr. Munir Ghazanfar and Dr. Nawaz Chaudhry. They mapped most of the area of NW Himalaya and defined the structural & tectonic boundaries. We are just on the way to acknowledge their work by learning and sharing the knowledge with GeoHikingClub. In the NW Himalaya, we covered Neelum, Kaghan, Basham, Sawat, Dir, Chitral Ghizar, Shigar, Skardu, Hunza, Khaplu valleys, Khunjrab Pass and Deosai in the last 7 episodes. In this 8th field trip, we will cover the western limb of HKS, MCT, MMT, MKT & Karakoram Range. From, Yasin Valley, travel back distance is almost same via Gilgit or Chitral, any one route may be adopted for return.

Our key objective is to learn and share the knowledge of the area's structure/tectonics/ stratigraphy/hydrology with professionals and academia to enhance the capabilities of the future geoscientists of Pakistan. **Therefore, you are welcome to join us to see the Geology, Culture and Scenic views of north Pakistan.**

Code of Ethics:

Our key intention is to learn the Geology of Pakistan. Therefore, we have been voluntarily arranging field excursions throughout the country. We have no hidden helping hands;

sometimes, donors are requested for financial support for the student's event only. There is no executive member/committee except those who serve better. We depend on self-cooking, self-service, and serving others during the trip. It's our prime responsibility to keep the country clean. Everyone is responsible for his act. For cleanliness, we keep plastic bags with us during our field trips to dispose of our waste properly.

No one will be allowed to swim or bathe in the river or aabshar (water fall) and make fun near glacier avalanches. Land sliding areas are predefined; therefore, we cross them when these are stable. Night travelling is almost avoided. After the completion of the event, a report is prepared for record and sharing the knowledge. Therefore, participants are requested to share the field data and pictures of the trip.

Location Map:

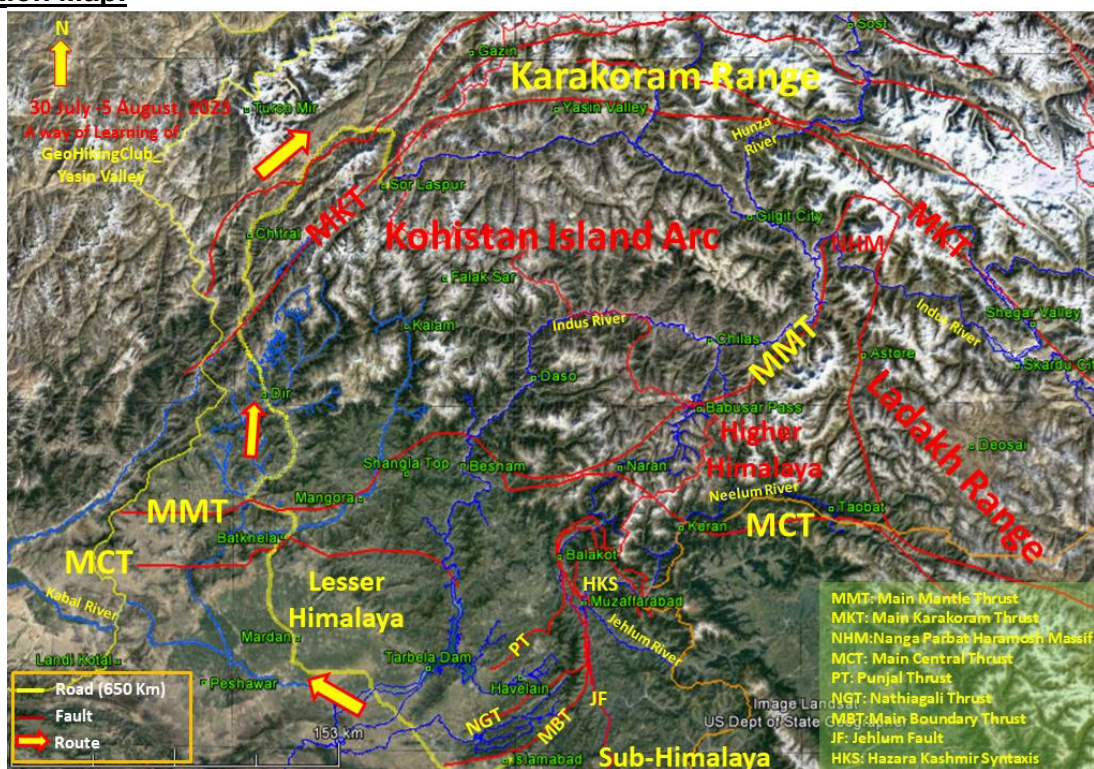


Figure 1: JF redrawn from maps of Dr Shahid Baig & PAPG, MCT and HKS taken from Dr. Munir Ghazanfar, PT redrawn from the map of Dr. Mir Lateef, NGT and MBT taken from Geological maps of Dr. Naveed Ahsan And Tariq Mahmood, MMT was modified from maps of Dr. Nawaz Chaudhry and and Munir Ghazanfar and Dr. Asif, MKT redrawn from Dr. Nawaz, Dr Asif , GSP. Faults in the north of MKT are courtesy of GSP.
